2. 3H

7. 3NT shows a big hand with a running minor suit
8. 1NT

10. 2D a reverse. Raise hearts on your next bid, showing 3 hts
11. 3C
12. 2D 3C jump rebid is not enough, you have 21 count; reverse is forcing for one round
13. 2H
14. 2C not good enough for a jump; weak suit, weak doubleton honours, downgrade hand
15. 1NT not a typo, this is the best of poor choices; 2C shows 6, only raise w 3hts if you have a singleton
(maybe they won't find the spade lead 😊)
16. 1NT
