

Declarer has quick tricks = ? 12 total tricks

What do we know after opening lead: West has H KQ

Possible extra trick : ? 4th D if suit breaks 3-3


but if not, perhaps...

if W has 4 ds, declarer can squeeze him for the 13th trick

Threat cards: ? 1. Declarer's 4th D, 2. JH

Guard suits are ? Ds and Hs by West

Play: Declarer cashes all winners exc. Ds. When declarer plays last trump, W cannot keep both the 4th D and the Q ht and is squeezed out of discarding one of these cards.





Play: Cash all winners; 4s, 3d, on the 4th d, E is stuck




Losers: 2 s, maybe 1 ht but finessing E for it, 1 C.

I will get u started. Lead the Ht 8 and finesse, lead the T and finesse again, 7 and again Trump are drawn in 4 rounds, East has discarded what ? ______ SQUEEZE ON !!



Long hts in E means W is likely having to guard the other 2 (minor) suits. This makes a squeeze quite likely.

You have 1 H loser, and 1 or 2 C losers. However, one club loser goes on extra D trick. The C7 return appears to be a singleton.

SQUEEZE AWAY !! and try to make SIX for a great board.
